## Queries:

When men go to the front, how many dependents will they leave behind?

*It is reported that the Social Service Commission is to be asked by the city government to secure this information.*

How many men will be thrown out of employment, leaving their families dependent?

*No agency now exists to record such unemployment as it becomes actual. No agency existing permanently for other purposes has been directed to secure such information and keep it currently available.*

Can the city or province do anything now toward supplying additional productive employment on work which must in any case be done sometime?
