The heads of the various city departments cannot see everything. If you know of any such condition which should be remedied, co-operate with them by bringing it to their notice.

Again, if you have practical suggestions which will improve and make for more efficiency in civic and educational administration, co-operate with your aldermen and school trustees by discussing such ideas with them.
