THE DIRECTORY

This Directory is produced every two years as a guide to the Municipality of Metro Toronto as well as the six area municipalities — East York, Etobicoke, North York, Scarborough, Toronto and York. The Directory has been organized by area and includes information on Councils, Standing Committees of Council, Boards and Commissions, as well as School and Separate School Boards. An index is provided at the beginning of each area to assist in locating information.

For those unfamiliar with the two levels of government a short outline of responsibilities might be useful. The Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto is the regional level of government. The 39 members of Metro Council are not directly elected but are the mayors, controllers, executive committee members and certain aldermen who are elected to one of the six area muncipalities. The Chairman is in turn elected by the Council.

There are certain services which are the sole responsibility of Metro Toronto. For example, transit, police, ambulance services, homes for the aged, welfare administration, convalescent hospitals, and licensing of businesses are all controlled at the Metro level. There are also a number of services and responsibilities which are shared with the area muncipalities. For example, major roads are under Metro while minor arterial roads are under local jurisdiction. The area muncipalities collect garbage while Metro disposes of it. Large recreational and cultural facilities are under Metro jurisdiction such as the Canadian National Exhibition, Metro Zoo, O'Keefe Centre, and the Toronto Islands. The area municipalities, however, provide the neighbourhood facilities such as parks, arenas, and recreational programs.

The area municipalities have local councils which are elected every two years. Each area has a Mayor who is the head of Council. Etobicoke, North York, Scarborough and York have Controllers who are elected at-large in elections and who, along with the Mayor, form the Board of Control. This group acts as the executive of council and has responsibility for preparing the budget, awarding contracts and supervising the municipal staff. In addition to the Mayor and Controllers, there are aldermen elected from each ward to form the local council.

The City of Toronto and East York do not have controllers but have 2 aldermen elected from each ward. Toronto Council then elects from among its members 4 individuals who along with the Mayor are the Executive Committee. East York does not have a separate Executive Committee; the Council as a whole serves this function.

The services provided at the local level are extensive and usually well known. In the Directory phone numbers are listed for local departments as well as boards and commissions. There are also, where available, general information numbers listed if you are uncertain which department you need to contact.

In the past this Directory has proved useful for anyone dealing with municipal government in the Metro area. We would like to thank all those who provided information to us for the 1981/82 edition.
