JOINT BOARDS

Metropolitan Toronto and Region Conservation Authority

The Authority consists of 26 members appointed by participating municipalities outside Metropolitan Toronto, the same number by Metropolitan Toronto, and one member, appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council, designated as Chairman. The Chief Officer is appointed by resolution of the Authority and is ex officio a member of the executive committee. The Authority elects its vice-chairman from among its members.
