BUREAU OF MUNICIPAL RESEARCH

Founded in 1914 by a group of public-spirited citizens; operated since then under provincial charter as a non-partisan, non-profit organization; staffed by full-time qualified personnel; the Bureau keeps local government operations in greater Toronto under constant scrutiny.
